## ***HORSE AND PONY CLASSES***

### **IMPORTANT - PLEASE READ BEFORE ENTERING!**

- **Closing date for entries 18<sup>th</sup> July. Entries received after this date will only be accepted at the discretion of the Horse Secretary and on payment of a penalty of £1.00 per class.**
  - **NO ENTRIES ARE TAKEN ON THE DAY, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF SHOW JUMPING AND FANCY DRESS WHICH ARE ONLY ON THE DAY**
  - Please ensure you have read the Society Rules in this schedule. Further information is available on the website – [www.weetonshow.co.uk](http://www.weetonshow.co.uk)
  - No entries accepted unless accompanied by correct entry fees and stamped addressed envelope.
  - Entries in Horse and Pony Section MUST quote name and age of horse and name and age of rider (where applicable)
  - Entries of £5.00 or more will entitle the exhibitor to one exhibitor ticket; entries over £10 will entitle the exhibitor to two exhibitor tickets. Exhibitor tickets will not be posted for entries received after the closing date. Anyone without an exhibitor's ticket will be charged for entry to the showground.
  - Hard hats/skull caps, that conform to current B.S.I standards or above, must be worn when mounted on the showground, at all times.
- There is a compulsory payment of £1.00 for each competitor to cover the provision of medical services.
  - The organisers accept no liability whatsoever for any accident, damage, injury, illness to horses/owners/riders or any other person or property.
  - Exhibitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to insure against damage caused by their animals.
  - Objections must be made in writing to the General Secretary with a deposit of £10. See Society rule 14.
  - All cups and trophies are to be returned to the Trophy Secretary 3 weeks before the show. See Society rule 19.
  - The Society will not be responsible for incorrect classification of exhibits.
  - Judging will start in each Ring promptly at the time indicated. Competitors are advised to be on the field early, as it is impossible to say how long each class will take. Class timings are subject to change.
  - Competitors are reminded that they should carry horse passports at all times and, those travelling in horseboxes, should be aware of height restrictions under railway bridges in the vicinity of the showground.
