1. No entries accepted unless accompanied by correct entry fees and stamped addressed envelope if requested.
2. Entries in Horse and Pony Section MUST quote name and age of horse and name and age of rider (where applicable)
3. Any horse entry arriving after the closing date will only be accepted at the Horse Secretary's discretion and on payment of a late entry fee of £1.00 per class.
The closing date for horse entries is 18th July 2009
4. No entries will be accepted on the day, except for Show Jumping, Children's Fancy Dress, Dog and Pet Sections.
5. Make cheques payable to **WEETON AND DISTRICT AGRICULTURAL & HORTICULTURAL SHOW SOCIETY** Do not send cash in the post.
6. Any non horse entry arriving after the closing date will be charged late entry fee of 25p

SHEEP SECTION OPEN RULES

Exhibitors in this section please note:

- Please ensure you have read the general society rules in the schedule or available online at www.weetonshow.co.uk
- Entry forms to be sent to the Secretary - A. Morphet, Banks Farm Cottage, Huby, Leeds, LS17 0ET
- Closing date for entries 18th July 2009. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Secretary and subject to a penalty of £1.00 per class.
- No entries accepted on the day.
- Entries of £4.50 or over will entitle the exhibitor to one exhibitor ticket. Posting of exhibitor tickets cannot be guaranteed for late entries.
- Judging will start promptly at 11.00 am. All sheep must be penned before 10.30 am and remain there until 4.00 pm.
- Sheep exhibited at this show must not be freshly dipped and be wet with dip. In preparing sheep for exhibition they must not be treated with a spray containing undiluted or very strong OP dip. Any product used at the show for treating sheep fleece should be marketed as suitable for this purpose and the appropriate precautions followed. Failure to comply will result in prize money being forfeited.
- It is the exhibitor's responsibility to complete two Movement Forms and hand them to the License Steward on the show day.
- Separate unloading/loading and penning arrangements have been made for sheep from MV accredited flocks. To use these facilities sheep must be accompanied by a valid certificate of status (please state on entry form).
- Exhibitors are reminded that it is their responsibility to insure against damage caused by their animals.
